

Welcome to the PreTime Disney KIT!


KIT refers to Keyboard Interactive Teaching. This KIT is a teacher's digital resource for teaching the PreTime Disney Book— group or private—for piano lessons online or in-person.

The KIT is composed of sharable slides for each song. The slides offer engaging instruction in note-reading, pattern recognition, symbols, melody, harmony, and scales and arpeggios to prepare the student for successful practice.


How to Use the Teacher Script

Review the slides and become familiar with the teacher script before teaching your students.

The script prompts quick,
2-way dialogue between teacher and student through engaging questions and explorations. Think of the script as your lesson plan or study guide.



18. Look! The last line of music is almost exactly the same as the top line. (Use cursor to compare measures.) Is m.13 the same as m. 9? (Say, "same-same") Are m.14 and m.10 same-same? m.15 and m.11? Notice in m.12 the LH. moves up to what note? (point with cursor)



As you become increasingly familiar with the slide content, the script will become just an easy cue. You may also adapt the script for your own natural teaching style and student response.

- 20. What's on the screen? There are lots of music symbols! Let's take turns and name something you see.
- 21. Your assignment is to learn I Just Can't Wait to Be King. I'm excited to hear you play it. Great job!

How to Use the "Born to Perform" Videos

Each song ends with a fun "Born to Perform" video. Assign the song video to watch each day for quick assimilation of technique, tempo, rhythm, and dynamics. Lyrics are included to encourage memorization and singing. And students will enjoy the *surprise Disney ending* for each video!

How to Offer a Disney Piano Camp

Consider a "Disney camp" for 2-6 students, online or in-person. The **Disney Kit** is designed for flexibility. For instance, a summer camp could be a two-week session with two lessons per week. 2-3 songs per session might be introduced to complete all or most of the book in 4 classes.

The KIT is loosely designed with the introduction of concepts following the song order of the book. However, activities may be adjusted according to the interest of your students and your own teaching style. Consider an online or in-person recital for your last Disney session!

Each student needs the following:

- Primer Level or Level 1 experience
- PreTime Disney Book
- Computer, tablet, or smartphone
- Video chat software (Zoom, Skype, etc.)
